Aspire Indiana uses MedInformatix platform supported by Archeon.

The Archeon EMR system software is a behavioral health specific joint development venture between MedInformatix, a highly regarded company in cardiology, radiology and ophthalmology, and Aspire Indiana. The system is a relational database that automatically pulls the necessary data to the right place at the right time to reduce redundancy and improve treatment.
